



DISTRICT 13 CONDITIONS OF CONTEST

2016-2017 NORTH AMERICAN PAIRS

Flights: A(Open), B (0-2500), C (0-499) Non-Life Masters

To determine Masterpoint holding, Masterpoints will be as of the June 2016 masterpoint cycle (processing through May 6, 2016) Masterpoints must include any masterpoints won in any other bridge organization other than the ACBL. A person or pair may represent a district in only one flight at the National level. The North American Pairs final will be a four-session event to be held at the Kansas City Spring NABC, March 9-19, 2017. A person is considered to live in District 13 if their principal residence as of June 1, 2016 is in District 13. The three top pairs in each flight will be offered the right to play in the tournament at the National level.

Qualifying

Club Level

Qualifying in the clubs in June, July and August of 2016 (in accordance with ACBL Conditions of Contest)

District Level

In order to play at the District Level a pair must qualify in their local clubs during the qualifying period of June-August. A person or pair may qualify more than once. The District tournament will be a one day, two session event. Pairs qualifying for the District finals will be posted on the District 13 website monthly, as the information is provided by club managers.
